WINNING FOR LIFE & LIBERTY




When Gov. Mike DeWine vetoed a measure passed by the legislature that would have protected children from transgender treatment and kept men out of women's sports and locker rooms, The Danbury Institute encouraged citizens to voice their support for an override of that veto in keeping with their Judeo-Christian values. In a similar effort, The Danbury Institute saw a judiciary committee in Maine recently end consideration of a bill that would have allowed the state to take a child away from parents if the parents declined to allow the child to receive "gender affirming care."
